Lastly, I want to inform you and your child of my expectations for them this year. I attempt to get my students to be responsible for their education. As expected, this is always a work in progress. I will be contacting you later in the school year to remind you about the activities checked below. I look forward to working with you this school year.

I have had a lot of parents and students ask me what Resource is so I have attached the following definition.

What Is Resource? RSP (or Resource) is a collection of services designed to support students with varying special needs. For many students, this requires intensive academic, speech,

behavioral, and/or emotional support. For other students, it may just be to have a person and place to go to when questions arise or a little extra assistance is needed. Whatever the needs of your student, the BHS IEP Team is here to help. Services may be provided by a Resource Specialist, Speech & Language Pathologist, Psychologist, Counselor, Occupational Therapist, and/or other Specialist, depending on your student's IEP.
